Guiding Principles

Women Centered Advocacy:

WC&S has adopted the Sanctuary Model, a holistic, full-system approach to meeting the physical and emotional needs of victims. Sanctuary is a method of providing service and engaging in activities and interactions that focuses on helping injured children and adults recover from damaging effects of interpersonal drama.

We educate the community and work to change systems in ways that will end intimate partner violence.
