

A CONFIDENTIALLY LOCATED SECURE EMERGENCY SHELTER, COMPLETE WITH SUPPORTIVE CHILDREN'S SERVICES AND A 24 HOUR HOTLINE, SERVED MORE THAN 3,000 UNDUPLICATED VICTIMS OF DOMESTIC ABUSE LAST YEAR. THE HOTLINE ANSWERED 5,941 CALLS AND SHELTER HOUSED 252 VICTIMS AND 219 CHILDREN FOR A TOTAL OF 14,439 NIGHTS. THE WOMEN AND CHILDREN WERE SERVED 43,335 NUTRITIONALLY BALANCED MEALS AND PROVIDED TOILETRIES, CLOTHING AND OTHER ESSENTIALS, TO INCLUDE TRANSPORTATION SERVICES. RESIDENT CHILDREN WERE INTRODUCED TO THOSE SERVED IN NONRESIDENT PROGRAMS THROUGH 10,640.11 HOURS OF DIRECT SERVICE AND STRUCTURED ACTIVITIES IN THE CHILDREN'S PROGRAM. WOMEN IN SHELTER ALSO RECEIVED 8,928.29 HOURS OF DIRECT SERVICES, INCLUDING COUNSELING, CASE MANAGEMENT, SUPPORT GROUPS AND HOUSING ADVOCACY.

IN APRIL OF 2011, WOMEN'S CENTER SURVEYED 250 WOMEN IN THE SUBURBAN RING OF PITTSBURGH. 37% OF RESPONDENTS SAID THEY HAD BEEN OR KNEW SOMEONE WHO WAS A VICTIM OF INTIMATE PARTNER VIOLENCE, BUT FEW KNEW WHERE TO TURN FOR HELP: 14.4% WERE AWARE OF THE WOMEN'S CENTER SHELTER, 7.1% WERE AWARE OF THE HOTLINE. THESE STATISTICS SHOW THE IMPORTANCE OF EDUCATION AND AWARENESS. ONLY BY EDUCATING THE COMMUNITY CAN WE WORK TO CHANGE SOCIETAL VIEWS AND UNDERSTANDING OF INTIMATE PARTNER VIOLENCE. ONCE AWARENESS IS HEIGHTENED, THEN CHANGE CAN BEGIN TO HAPPEN.
SHORTLY AFTER THIS SURVEY WAS CONDUCTED, WOMEN'S CENTER LAUNCHED ITS FIRST RELATIONSHIPS CAMPAIGN. THE CAMPAIGN TOOK PLACE OVER AN 8 MONTH PERIOD AND INCLUDED RADIO SPOTS, TELEVISION PSAS, OUTDOOR BILLBOARDS,
