When you think of WC&S' work to provide safety and support, your mind may immediately go to our Emergency Shelter. While that is a critical and life-saving WC&S program (and we are taking great care of the residents and children!), only 6% of our clients are served by our Shelter. The quotes above are words of thanks from non-resident clients who have recently received care packages of supplies and/or gift cards because of your incredible generosity. Like so many others, they are doing the best they can to take care of their families while coping with job loss, social distancing, and the trauma they've experienced.

Each year, WC&S serves 7,500 adults and children through our non-resident programs and services such as Legal Advocacy, the Immediate Needs Coordination Program, CYF (Children, Youth and Families) Program, Support Groups, Individual Counseling and much more. Right now, WC&S Advocates are working hard to provide direct services for continued healing while addressing basic needs. And, while this is work they've always done, the need among clients is growing and will continue to do so well into the future.

To further our efforts, WC&S has put together a COVID-19 Rapid Response Team who is actively ensuring that we are providing care to all of our clients while doing outreach in the community to connect with new clients. It's more important than ever to make survivors aware of the help available to them.
