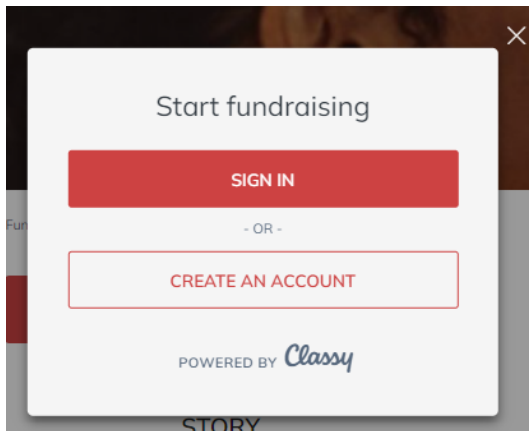
1. Visit the Adopt-A-Family Fund donation page by scanning the QR code with your phone or by visiting bit.ly/WCSHOLIDAYS.



2. Click the "Become a Fundraiser" button on the Adopt-A-Family Fund giving page.

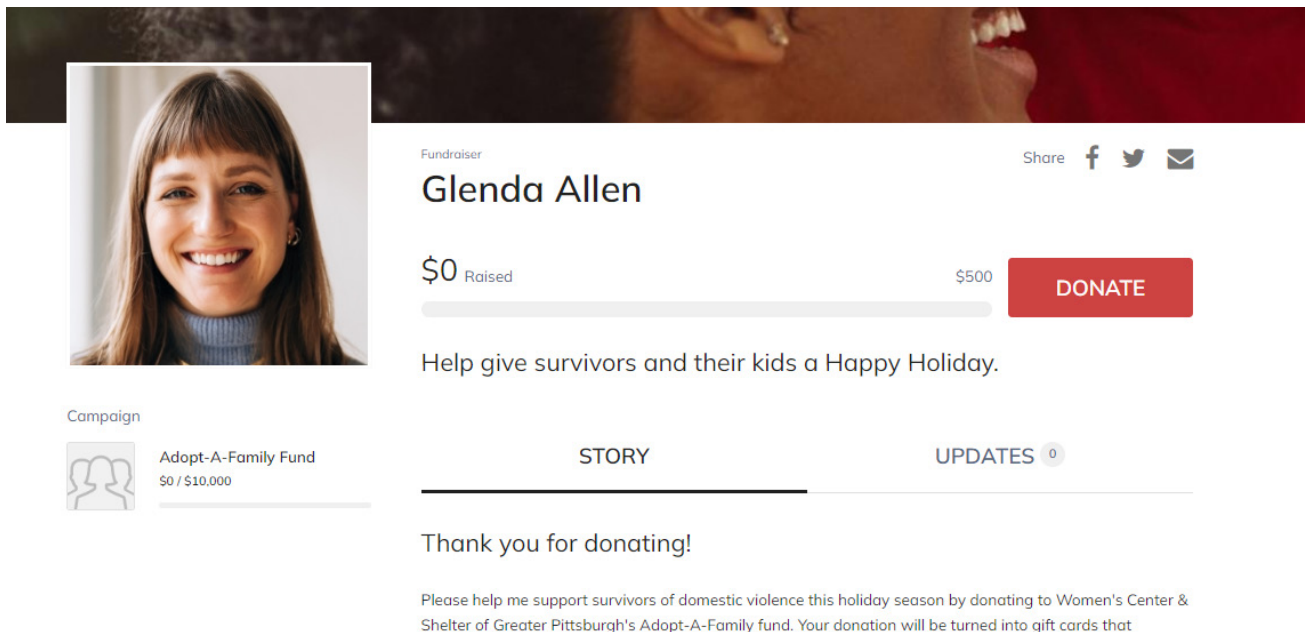
